Currently, the active groups are:

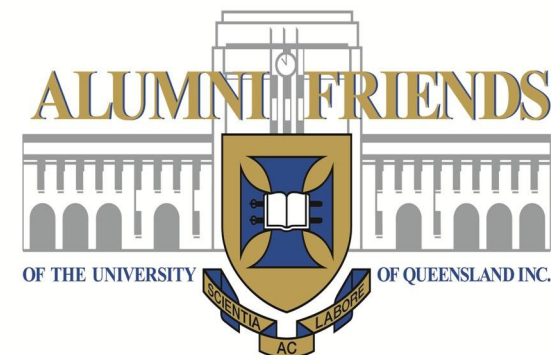
- **Alumni Book Fair** – held biennially and a major source of fund-raising

Alumni Friends of The University of Queensland Inc. (Alumni Friends) was the first Alumni Association to be formed at any Australian University and has been a major UQ donor for well over four decades.

It is a volunteer organisation whose members have collectively contributed well over \$8 million in direct financial assistance to The University of Queensland (UQ) since its inception in 1967 plus countless hours of volunteer service by its alumni and friends members directly, therefore additionally benefitting UQ.

Members are from every discipline and profession and are welcome to participate, not only in activities in their immediate area, but in other disciplines as well.

While most members are graduates of The University of Queensland, members of the wider community and graduates of any other university are welcome to join and to participate in activities.

Alumni Friends is a body incorporated under the Associations Incorporations Act 1981 (QLD).

On 17 May, 2008. at a Special General Meeting, members voted to change the association's name from Alumni Association Inc. to Alumni Friends of The University of Queensland Inc.
